

Good News: CACC Chinese School Has Added Three New Math Olympia Classes

Dear parents and friends,

Due to high demand by students and parents, CACC Chinese School has added three new Math Olympia classes. To facilitate more smooth registration in the summer, your children do not need to have any permission or take any test to get into the following three classes at this point:

Beginner: MO-103 for students age 10 to 11: 10 to 10:50am

Intermediate: MO-203 for students age 12 to 13: 11-11:50am

Advanced: MO-303 for students age 13 to 14: 12 to 12:50pm

However, students will take assessment test when school starts. Please pay attention to the following important issues before you sign up for one of the classes:

1. These classes are very competitive, therefore it is critical for the parents to understand that it is hard for any child to become successful in the class if he/she does not love math or math competition.
2. Grade or age is very important for these classes. Students are much more likely to be successful if they begin Math Olympia when they are at least in 5th grade or higher when they have enough math knowledge and/or maturity to handle competition and related stress.
3. WE WANT TO WORK WITH YOU AND YOUR CHILDREN TO MAKE THEM LOVE MATH OR MATH COMPETITION AFTER THE CLASS. PLEASE DO NOT PUSH THEM TO TAKE THE CLASS AND/OR TO GO TO A HIGHER LEVEL IF THEY ARE NOT READY OR DO NOT LIKE MATH.

Student success and program quality are important for our school. WE WANT TO BUILD THE BEST COMPETITIVE MATH PROGRAM FOR OUR STUDENTS, AND WE NEED YOUR HELP AND SUPPORT. Please register and pay for the classes as soon as possible. The school wants to make sure that we will have enough time to work with a new teacher and the other two teachers in the summer to come up with the best curriculum and competition plans for our students for the next year.

If you think one of the classes is good for your children, please go to our website www.caccusa.org to register and pay for these classes as soon as you can. **ANY UNPAID REGISTRATION AFTER 14 DAYS WILL BE CANCELED (IF YOU HAVE REGISTERED BUT FAILED TO PAY WITHIN 14 DAYS OF YOUR REGISTRATION), AND THE SPACE WILL BE RELEASED AUTOMATICALLY TO OTHER STUDENTS.**

Many students want to take these classes, and we want to make sure they have the opportunity to achieve that goal.

questions you may have for the registration and other school related issues. Please read it carefully before sending emails to the office.

8th grade students from Pleasanton can also take our high school Chinese I, II, III, and IV from 9 to 11:50am and then take MO-303 from 12 to 12:00pm or the advanced tennis for middle school or high school students from 12 to 12:50pm.
